## ADMISSION CRITERIA AND SCALE OF ACCESS TO THE DART PROGRAM Academic Year 2021-2022

### 1. Academic merits (40%)

---

- Academic record corresponding to an Artistic Education Higher Degree, University Degree, University Master's Degree or Artistic Education Master's Degree.
- Scholarships and pre-doctoral or research initiation grants.
- Artistic training scholarships

In addition, in this section, special consideration will be given to those degrees that provide added value due to their affinity or complement to the DART program, and the suitability of previous degrees or higher degrees to the field of artistic research and applied musical research.

### 2. Artistic training and research merits (40%)

---

- Courses, seminars, conferences given.
- Courses, seminars received.
- Publications (articles, books...) and artistic projects developed.
- Premieres and artistic creations.
- Interpretations and artistic performances.
- Participation in working groups, research and innovation projects.
- Participation in seminars, congresses, scientific conferences.
- Professional experience as a teacher/guide/pedagogical advisor, in the field of artistic education (music schools, academic, professional conservatories and higher conservatories).
- B1 in English or equivalent, accredited by official certification.
- Presentation of an endorsement from a professor of the DART program or a researcher of recognized prestige with availability to assume the co-direction of the thesis.

### 1. Other merits (20%)

---

- Presentation to the Academic Committee of a brief report (maximum length of three pages) on the research project that aspires to develop in any of the lines of research contemplated by the DART program.

- Motivation letter in which the applicant's interest in developing his/her doctoral thesis within the DART program is made clear, and argues his/her capacity to carry out his/her doctoral thesis project.
- Personal interview with the management of the DART program and the IKG who will assess the motivation and personal commitment of the student.

## **IMPORTANT**

- Admission to the program will require a minimum score of 6 points.
- The application of the scale and the subsequent decision on the admission of applicants will be the responsibility of the Academic Council of the IKG.
